



Foundation Class

Welcome to the Autumn term, here is a flavour of what your child will be doing in class in the next few weeks. The broad theme for this term is Bears and then the children's choice for the 2nd half term.



In mathematical development, we will be covering numbers in the environment, number properties, counting and recording patterns.



In communication and language, and literacy we are looking at traditional stories, phonics (learning a sound, letter and action a day), letter formation and sound recognition.



In Expressive Arts and Design we will be looking at using a range of joining techniques, colour mixing, singing and role play activities.



In understanding The World we will be learning how to log onto and use a simple drawing programme on the computers, we will become history detectives to find out about our own and parent's past and investigate how water moves. Forest school will be each Tuesday afternoon.



In personal, social and emotional development we are following the PATHS programme. We are learning to play co-operatively and to try new activities.



In physical development we will be basing our dance lessons on teddy bears for the first half term. We will be using the large apparatus and games equipment. The activities mentioned in other subjects also come into this section. The outdoor area is constantly in use with a range of activities that encourage children to explore and learn through play. Managing their own basic hygiene and dressing independently are also a focus.
